Join the National Rural Higher Education Research Center for an afternoon of research, discussion, networking, and reflection focused on timely issues shaping rural higher education.

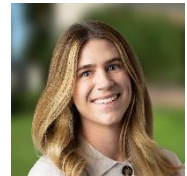
The event will feature three presentations on recent research findings, along with opportunities to connect with community college leaders working across the rural higher education field.

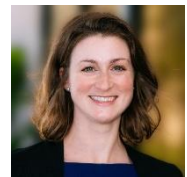
